This table provides detail for determining the Instructional Units (IU) of faculty as outlined in the Handbook in section 2.8.4.H. All full-time faculty are required to teach a minimum of 24 IU and a maximum of 26 IU during the academic year. Department chairs and Program directors will submit an IU calculation using the information below to their respective Dean by the midpoint of each semester. This report will be reviewed and submitted to the Office of Academic Affairs. Faculty who are found to be in overload status will be duly compensated during the May pay period.
